- Professional learning: facilitation of life skills activities



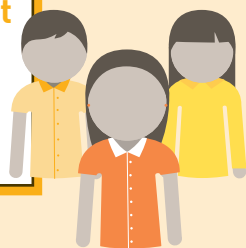
Mentoring
